



CATHOLIC PARTNERSHIP SCHOOLS REOPENING PLAN

The information provided below are the general guidelines in place for the reopening.

Groups	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • All classes with enrollment greater than 10 will be split A/B. • The A group will attend school in person on Monday and Wednesday. (They will have online instruction on Tuesday, Thursday, and Friday) • The B group will attend school on Tuesday and Thursday. (They will have online instruction on Monday, Wednesday, and Friday)
Attire	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Students will be required to wear their uniforms while in school. • Students will be required to wear school appropriate attire during virtual learning.
Instructional Day	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The instructional school day will take place from 8 am - 1 pm.
Screening	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Students with pre-existing conditions may need to have a doctor's note stating that they are well enough to attend school. • All students entering the building will have their temperature checked upon entry. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - If students have a temperature of 100° or more, their temperature will be logged and they will be sent home. • Students who arrive unescorted with a temperature will be held in the nurse's office or another secured, isolated room until a parent can be reached to pick them up. • Teachers will also take the temperature during the day of students exhibiting symptoms. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Teachers will document the student temperature checks. - If a student has a temperature of 100° or more, they will be sent to the nurse/office and sent home. • All temperatures will be taken using touchless thermometers.
PPE/ Masking	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • All students, grades PreK through 8 and staff will be required to wear a mask at all times.
Classroom Configurations	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • All CPS classrooms will contain one of the following two configurations depending on the classroom size and number of students assigned to the classroom. <p>Configuration 1</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • A 6-foot distance is maintained between students when they are seated at their desks. • A mask must be worn by all students at all times. <p>Configuration 2</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • A distance of no less than 3 feet, and as close to 6 feet as possible, is maintained between students when they are seated at their desks. • All students are behind a three-sided barrier while at their desks. • Students are required to wear masks at all times.

Hygiene	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• All schools have a full-time nurse.• Every classroom is equipped with a touchless thermometer.• Masks<ul style="list-style-type: none">- Students will be encouraged to bring their own, but schools have a supply of disposable masks.• Gloves will be available for screenings and cleaning.• Hand Sanitizer will be provided:<ul style="list-style-type: none">- Before and after morning screenings and- To all students as they enter the building.• Hand sanitizing stations will be present in all classrooms and throughout the schools.• Signage for handwashing will be in all restrooms.• Touchless Water Fountains have been ordered.• Antibacterial Soap will be available in all restrooms.• Disposable paper towels will be available in all restrooms.
Food Service	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Five breakfasts and five lunches, plus milk, will be given to each student to take home on Mondays or Tuesdays depending upon which group they have been assigned.
